Free English Class (FEC)

Free English Classes (FEC)

Operationalization of new centers:

Jeopardy activity:

Our Jeopardy game host Ms. Avantika Haflongbar conducted Jeopardy sessions at the Vasant Gaon, Okhla Tehkhand, Zakir Nagar, Tigri, Sangam Vihar #1, Sangam Vihar #2 and Upkar Colony centers.

Ms. Avantika also conducted the first Jeopardy training for 17 facilitators from May 4 - 6. This will enable our facilitators to run Jeopardy independently in their centers and to slowly incorporate it as a regular part of the FEC program.

Induction Training:

Seventeen candidates attended these programs, of which 10 were selected to take up their positions at the various centers.

Training program for facilitators:

Training program for existing facilitators is organized periodically. Training for Month 2 & 3 Level 1 curriculum was organized from May 23-25. Ms. Payal Mahajan and Mr. Mohan conducted this training program for eighteen facilitators from different FEC centers.

Month 4 Training: Month 4 training from May 29 - 30 for twelve fa training was conducted by Ms. Payal Mahajan.



AAM Foundation Training Academy:

To keep up with the professional development needs of the FEC program, AAMF has started a Training Academy. The aim of the academy is to provide remedial intervention to new and existing facilitators and to upgrade the language skills of aspirants who would like to join our centers as facilitators. Ms Anubha Sehgal has been appointed as the Head of the Training Academy.

The first batch of the Training Academy completed a month-long intensive training program in grammar, pronunciation and facilitation skills, conducted from 6 May to 1 June 2013.

Meal a Day Program

AAMF feeding centers provide food to 700 people every day in different slums / villages across Delhi. Our 5 feeding centers offer a hot nutrition meal consisting of rice and vegetables to the acutely hungry. AAMF ensures that the food distributed at the centers is safe and of good quality.

Health-care facility

Each month AAMF organizes a medical camp at its feeding centers. At this camp, a volunteer physician visits the center and examines children and distributes medicines to the sick. The physician also provides information about vaccinations and other medical services for children to accompanying parents. Additionally, he advises parents on sickness preventive measures relating to water and mosquitoes-borne diseases.
